- Approximately 1 in 3 young people be in an abusive or unhealthy relationship.
- Young people, ages 16-24, experience the highest rate of relationship violence of all age groups.
- Abusive or violent behavior often begins between 6th and 12th grade.







- An incident of domestic violence occurs approximately every 8 minutes in the state of New Jersey.
- Nearly 3 out of 4 (74%) Americans personally know someone who is or has been a victim of domestic violence.
- Some of the most common reasons victims give for not being able to ask for help is fear of the abuser's violence, fear of not being believed, and fear of not being helped.
